2022 MR AGUA Season Starter Saturday – Sunday October 8-9, 2022

SANCTION: Held under the sanction of USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming, Inc.

LOCATION: Asphalt Green AguaCenter—1750 York Ave. (Corner of 91st St. and York Ave.)

FACILITY: Eight (8) 25-yard lanes with minimum depth 6 ft. 7 in.

One (1) 20-yard lanes will be provided for continuous warm up/warm down.

The pool has **not** been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C(4).

SESSIONS: Saturday 9-10/11-12 Warm-up 8:00 AM Start 9:00 AM

Saturday 13 & Over Warm-up 1:15 PM Start 2:15 PM

Sunday 9-10/11-12 Warm-up 8:00 AM Start 9:00 AM

Sunday 11 & Over Warm-up 1:00PM Start 1:30PM

Sunday 8 & Under Warm-up 3:00 PM Start 3:30 PM

FORMAT: All events are timed finals. Deck seeding will be used.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers accompanied by

a coach. All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the

meet. Age on October 8 will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the meet director if you need

special consideration.

SWIMMERS: The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any

disability prior to the competition.

ENTRIES: Swimmers will be limited to three (3) events per session. Entries are limited and will be on

a first come, first served basis. Entries should be submitted in Hy-Tek Meet Manager

form.

Host Club may waive meet entry fees & facility surcharge for registered outreach swimmers. Coaches should contact meet director and identify registered swimmers whom they wish considered for waiver of fees when submitting meet entries.

DEADLINE:

- 1. Metro LSC teams will be given priority on a first come, first served basis. Metro team entries must be received by **September 28, 2022**.
- 2. The final entry deadline for this meet is October 1, 2022.
- 3. Metro entries received between **September 20**, **2022** and **October 1**, **2022** and all entries from other LSCs will be entered in the order they were received, as space allows.

An entry receipt confirmation will be emailed if you provide an email contact. Please contact the Entry Contact if you do not receive such a report within two days of your original email.

ENTRY FEE:

There is a \$20.00 surcharge per athlete. The entry fee is \$10.00 per individual event. Make check payable to: Asphalt Green.

Payment must be received by **October 8, 2022** for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries.

Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.

WARM-UP:

General warm-up with feet-first entry only. Doors for all coaches, athletes and spectators will open 30 minutes prior to warm-up. Sprint Lanes will be designated 10 minutes prior to the start of the session.

COACHES:

In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS:

Ribbons 1st—3 rd place for 9-12 athletes and 1st—8th place for 8 & Under age groups. All awards will be distributed to coaches only at the end of the meet. No individual awards will be distributed. Awards will not be mailed or forwarded.

MAAP:

RULES: The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.

The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet.

The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

Meet Director has discretion to modify meet format to comply with USA Swimming timeline rules.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present

SAFETY:

Metropolitan safety and warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules.

Number of Athletes: Each session will be limited to 400 athletes.
