FACILITY:	Eight (8) 25-yard lanes with minimum depth 6 ft. 7 in. One (1) 20-yard lanes will be provided for continuous warm up/warm down. The pool has not been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C(4).
	Water depth on the start end of the pool is 7'2" at both 1-meter and 5-meters out. Water depth on the turn end of the pool is 14'8" 5-meters out and 16'0" at 1-meter.

DEADLINE:	The final entry deadline for this meet is January 6 , 2023 . Entries received between December 1 , 2022 and January 6 , 2023 and all entries from other LSCs will be entered in the order they were received, as space allows. Teams not invited but wishing to attend may contact the meet director.
	An entry receipt confirmation will be emailed if you provide an email contact. Please contact the Entry Contact if you do not receive such a report within two days of your original email.
ENTRY FEE:	There is a \$20.00 surcharge per athlete. The entry fee is \$10.00 per individual event. Make check payable to: <u>Asphalt Green</u> .
	Payment must be received by January 14, 2023 for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.
WARM-UP:	General warm-up with feet-first entry only. Doors for all coaches, athletes and spectators will open 30 minutes prior to warm-up. Sprint Lanes will be designated 10 minutes prior to the start of the session.
COACHES:	In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.
AWARDS:	Ribbons for 12 & under athletes (1 st —8 th place). All awards will be distributed to coaches only at the end of the meet. No individual awards will be distributed. Awards will not be mailed or forwarded.

RULES:	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply. The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the Meet Referee. Meet Director has discretion to modify meet format to comply with USA Swimming timeline rules.
SAFETY:	Metropolitan safety and warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules.
	Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement.
LOCKER ROOMS:	Swimmers are permitted to use the Guest or Family Locker Rooms Only. The

- Second-Floor Restrooms will be designated 18 and over bathrooms.
- **DECK CHANGING:** Deck changes are prohibited.
